Rebekah Bogard received her MFA from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in 2003. She received a BFA from the University of Wyoming in Laramie in 2000. She is currently an associate professor in ceramics at University of Nevada, Reno as well as a studio artist.

She has received numerous awards including being named an "Emerging Artist" by both the National Council on Education for the Ceramic Arts and *Ceramics Monthly Magazine*.

In addition she is a two-time recipient of the Nevada Fine Arts Council Fellowship. Her work has been reviewed in publications such as *Art in America*, *LA Times*, *Sculpture Magazine*, *Artweek*, *Ceramics Monthly Magazine*, and *Clay Times Magazine*.
