**Location:** California State University, San Bernardino  
5500 University Parkway  
San Bernardino, CA 92407-2318

The museum is located on the far northeast corner of the university campus.

**Hours:** Tuesday, Wednesday: 10 a.m.–5 p.m.  
Thursday: 10 a.m.–7 p.m.  
Friday, Saturday: 10 a.m.–5 p.m.  
Sunday: closed  
Monday: closed

**Admission:** Free

**Collection:** The Robert V. Fullerton Art Museum – housing many objects from the Harer Family Trust Collection of Egyptian Antiquities – is considered the largest public display of ancient Egyptian art west of the Mississippi River. Established in 1996, the Fullerton Art Museum has accumulated a permanent collection of nearly 1,200 objects focusing on ceramics, and ancient and contemporary art; the largest of these collections include some 400 pieces spanning more than 5,000 years of Egyptian history.

**Programs:** In the past 10 years the Robert V. Fullerton Art Museum has been host to more than 150 emerging artists and 50,000 visitors, including an average of 8,000 school children per year. Beyond the regularly scheduled gallery talks, monthly art history lectures and an active membership program, the museum hosts an annual Summer Egyptian Workshop for Kids. The workshop offers children from the local community a week-long hands-on learning experience of ancient Egyptian art and history.

**Parking:** Parking permit: \$4  
Parking is available in lots M, A or L. Special permits for lot M available



at the museum from desk; permits for other lots available in drive-up dispensers or at the information pyramid at the CSUSB campus entrance.

**Directions:**

From Los Angeles:

Take I-10 East to I-15 North to 215 freeway South  
Exit **University Parkway**, turn left, going north.

From Riverside/San Diego:

Take the 215 freeway North.  
Exit **University Parkway**, turn right, going north.

From **University Parkway**, turn left onto Northpark Boulevard.

Turn Right onto Sierra Drive.

After 4-way stop, continue along the side road that will curve between buildings. Lot M is on the right, while lots A and L are on the left.

The Robert V. Fullerton Art Museum is located on the east end of the Visual Art Center.
