May 29 & May 30
At the museum front entrance
10:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

Submissions will be reviewed on **May 31**, and unaccepted artworks will be returned on **June 1-6** during museum hours. The exhibition will be on display **June 16 - July 31**.

Every year, the artworks in the student art exhibition are selected by an outside juror, decided by the Department of Art faculty members. This year's juror is curator and art critic, Shana Nys Dambrot!

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Faculty approval required for each entry
- Max. 3 entries (Any combination of medium)
- Please make sure that your artwork is display ready at the time of drop off. Paint is completely dry, 2-D artwork has some mechanism for hanging (preferably framed, velcro/magnets/etc. are ok with faculty approval.) If you are unsure how to display your work, please consult your professors. Please note: decisions about how or where work is to be displayed will be left to the RAFFMA staff. Consultations with artists will be held in the event that clarification is needed.
- An entry is a single work, which may be composed of several pieces, e.g. a series of photographs, a set of bowls, etc. Please note: due to limited space, we may ask you to edit down your entry.
- Video submissions must be .mov and can be submitted via flashdrive or CD.
